Matthew 6:19-24 Do Not Be Anxious

²⁵ "Therefore I tell you, do not be anxious about your life, what you will eat or what you will drink, nor about your body, what you will put on. Is not life more than food, and the body more than clothing? ²⁶ Look at the birds of the air: they neither sow nor reap nor gather into barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not of more value than they? ²⁷ And which of you by being anxious can add a single hour to his span of life? ^[2] ²⁸ And why are you anxious about clothing? Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow: they neither toil nor spin, ²⁹ yet I tell you, even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these. ³⁰ But if God so clothes the grass of the field, which today is alive and tomorrow is thrown into the oven, will he not much more clothe you, O you of little faith? ³¹ Therefore do not be anxious, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?' ³² For the Gentiles seek after all these things, and your heavenly Father knows that you need them all. ³³ But seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be added to you.

³⁴ "Therefore do not be anxious about tomorrow, for tomorrow will be anxious for itself. Sufficient for the day is its own trouble.

Father help us to remember that you have promised to provide for all our needs as we seek first your kingdom and your righteousness. Thank you that you have made us righteous through what Jesus did at the cross. Thank you Jesus that you have provided us a way to the Father and that you have shown us that we can go to the Father with our requests and that He will answer our prayers.

1. Repent

- -Repent for not coming to you.

- -Anywhere it hasn't been beneficial to me.
- -Repent for holding on and not letting go.
- Repent for not coming to you, our source of life.
- -Repent for not trusting God. Repent for believing a lie.
- -Repent for placing limits on God.
- -Repent for carrying burdens alone.
- -Repent for picking up and agreeing with pride and false humility, victim mentality, and self-righteousness.
- -We even repent for acting pious in what we put ourselves through instead of loving you.

- -We choose to believe there is a new way to live and we invite you to teach us...
- 3. We come to you and actively lay down our burdens at the feet of Jesus...
- -sin that weighs us down & grief from loss, illnesses, weight of an important role,
- -Lay down what burdens us, worries us, stresses us, weighs us down, entangles us, what we carry, etc
- 1 Peter 5:7 "Give all your worries and cares to God, for he cares about you."
- 4. Let him care for you
- -Now that we aren't carrying our burdens, care for our hearts.
- -Receive care for...hurts, wounds, past, fear of future, etc
- -Receive the father's embrace, the son's embrace, and the spirits embrace

Matthew 11:30

- ³⁰ For my yoke is easy to bear, and the burden I give you is light.
- 5. Choose to accept Jesus' easy yoke and light burden
- -Receive the words of God and choose to hold onto these

Hebrews 12:1-2 "Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a huge crowd of witnesses to the life of faith, let us strip off every weight that slows us down, especially the sin that so easily trips us up.
