Ministry Foundations

The goal of this ministry is to help you live the reality of a rich and satisfying life by knowing the truth of who you are in Christ. Self-identification leads to a confusing false identity. Allowing Jesus, the One who loves you more than anyone in the world, to establish your identity leads to healing, freedom, confidence and validation. Take time daily to read, pray and speak out loud the truths on the I Am Card to establish your true identity in Jesus Christ.

Salvation: Relationship with Jesus

Salvation is the foundation of this ministry. Having a personal, committed relationship with Jesus is the key to unlocking the freedom, clarity, and empowerment provided by His grace.

Romans 10:9-11

⁹ And what is God’s ‘living message’? It is the revelation of faith for salvation, which is the message that we preach. For if you publicly declare with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will experience salvation. ¹⁰ The heart that believes in him receives the gift of the righteousness of God—and then the mouth gives thanks to salvation. ¹¹ For the Scriptures encourage us with these words: ‘Everyone who believes in him will never be disappointed.’”

2 Corinthians 5:21

²¹ For God made the only one who did not know sin to become sin for us, so that we who did not know righteousness might become the righteousness of God through our union with him.”

Ephesians 2:8-9

⁸ For it was only through this wonderful grace that we believed in him. Nothing we did could ever earn this salvation, for it was the gracious gift from God that brought us to Christ! ⁹ So no one will ever be able to boast, for salvation is never a reward for good works or human striving.”

Acts 16:30-31

³⁰ Then he led Paul and Silas outside and asked, “What must I do to be saved?”
³¹ They answered, ‘Believe in the Lord Jesus and you will be saved—you and all your family.’”

Water Baptism

Water Baptism is an outward expression of an inward decision to surrender to Jesus. It proclaims that we are not ashamed of Him, and we choose to live for Him. Baptism symbolizes the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus. We identify with Jesus when we are baptized. Baptism is a commandment from Him. Baptism is an act of our obedience. Our covenant with God is the most secure relationship we will ever have, and water baptism is our tangible demonstration of our covenant with Him.

Matthew 28:19-20

¹⁹ Now go in my authority and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. ²⁰ And teach them to faithfully follow all that I have commanded you. And never forget that I am with you every day, even to the completion of this age.”

Acts 2:38

³⁸ Peter replied, “Repent and return to God, and each one of you must be baptized in the name of Jesus, the Anointed One to have your sins removed. Then you may take hold of the gift of the Holy Spirit.”

Romans 6:3-5

³ Or have you forgotten that all of us who were immersed into union with Jesus, the Anointed One, were immersed into union with his death? ⁴ Sharing in his death by our baptism means that we were co-buried and entombed with him, so that when the Father’s glory raised Christ from the dead, we were also raised with him. We have been co-resurrected with him so that we could be empowered to walk in the freshness of new life. ⁵ For since we are permanently grafted into him to experience a death like his, then we are permanently grafted into him to experience a resurrection like his and the new life that it imparts.”

Communion

Jesus first instituted communion with His disciples just before His crucifixion, and He commanded us to do this in remembrance of Him. Communion reminds us of the most important element of our faith—the love that Jesus revealed to us on the cross. The curse of sin was removed from our lives as it was placed upon His own body. His blood was also shed to remove our sins so we could have an eternal and intimate relationship with God. Communion is one of the most sacred foundations of the Christian faith. At Trinity Fellowship, we serve communion every week, but it can be taken daily. Communion is the ongoing covenant sign of our relationship with the Lord.

Luke 22:19-20

¹⁹ Then he lifted up a loaf, and after praying a prayer of thanksgiving to God, he gave each of his apostles a piece of bread, saying, “This loaf is my body, which is now being offered to you. Always eat it to remember me.”

²⁰ After supper was over, he lifted the cup again and said, “This cup is my blood of the new covenant I make with you, and it will be poured out soon for all of you.”

1 Corinthians 11:23-32

²³ I have handed down to you what came to me by direct revelation from the Lord himself. The same night in which he was handed over, he took bread ²⁴ and gave thanks. Then he distributed it to the disciples and said, “Take it and eat your fill. It is my body, which is given for you. Do this to remember me.” ²⁵ He did the same with the cup of *wine* after supper and said, “This cup seals the new covenant with my blood. Drink it—and whenever you drink this, do it to remember me.” ²⁶ Whenever you eat this bread and drink this cup, you are retelling the story, proclaiming our Lord’s death until he comes. ²⁷ For this reason, whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in the wrong spirit will be guilty of dishonoring the body and blood of the Lord. ²⁸ So let each individual first evaluate his own attitude and only then eat the bread and drink the cup. ²⁹ For continually eating and drinking with a wrong spirit will bring judgment upon yourself by not recognizing the body. ³⁰ This insensitivity is why many of you are weak, chronically ill, and some even dying. ³¹ If you do not sit in judgment of others, you will avoid judgment yourself. ³² But when we are judged, it is the Lord’s training so that we will not be condemned along with the world.”

Galatians 3:13-14

¹³ Yet, Christ paid the full price to set us free from the curse of the law. He absorbed it completely as he became a curse in our place. For it is written: “Everyone who is hung upon a tree is doubly cursed.”^[a]

¹⁴ Jesus, our Messiah, was cursed in our place and in so doing, dissolved the curse from our lives, so that all the blessings of Abraham can be poured out upon even non-Jewish believers. And now God gives us the promise of the wonderful Holy Spirit who lives within us when we believe in him.”

The Baptism of Holy Spirit

We receive the baptism of the Holy Spirit by asking God and receiving by faith, just as we receive Jesus when we are saved. The baptism of the Holy Spirit empowers, strengthens and comforts us.

Luke 11:13

“¹³ If imperfect parents know how to lovingly take care of their children and give them what they need, how much more will the perfect heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit’s fullness when his children ask him.”

Acts 1:4-5

“⁴ Jesus instructed them, ‘Don’t leave Jerusalem, but wait here until you receive the gift I told you about, the gift the Father has promised. ⁵ For John baptized you in water, but in a few days from now you will be baptized in the Holy Spirit!’”

Acts 1:8

“⁸ But I promise you this—the Holy Spirit will come upon you and you will be filled with power. And you will be my messengers to Jerusalem, throughout Judea, the distant provinces—even to the remotest places on earth!”

Acts 2:4

“⁴ They were all filled and equipped with the Holy Spirit and were inspired to speak in tongues—empowered by the Spirit to speak in languages they had never learned!”

Acts 4:31

“³¹ At that moment the earth shook beneath them, causing the building they were in to tremble. Each one of them was filled with the Holy Spirit, and they proclaimed the word of God with unrestrained boldness.”

Freedom: Winning our Spiritual Battle

Jesus has given us weapons for spiritual warfare so that we might walk in complete freedom. Jesus' victory has given us the victory! It is our privilege and responsibility to use these weapons to stand victoriously in every area of our life.

Ephesians 6:10-18

¹⁰ Now my beloved ones, I have saved these most important truths for last: Be supernaturally infused with strength through your life-union with the Lord Jesus. Stand victorious with the force of his explosive power flowing in and through you. ¹¹ Put on God's complete set of armor provided for us, so that you will be protected as you fight against the evil strategies of the accuser!

¹² Your hand-to-hand combat is not with human beings, but with the highest principalities and authorities operating in rebellion under the heavenly realms. For they are a powerful class of demon-gods and evil spirits that hold this dark world in bondage.

¹³ Because of this, you must wear all the armor that God provides so you're protected as you confront the slanderer, for you are destined for all things and will rise victorious. ¹⁴ Put on truth as a belt to strengthen you to stand in triumph. Put on holiness as the protective armor that covers your heart. ¹⁵ Stand on your feet alert, then you'll always be ready to share the blessings of peace.

¹⁶ In every battle, take faith as your wrap-around shield, for it is able to extinguish the blazing arrows coming at you from the Evil One!

¹⁷⁻¹⁸ Embrace the power of salvation's full deliverance, like a helmet to protect your thoughts from lies. And take the mighty razor-sharp Spirit-sword of the spoken Word of God. Pray passionately in the Spirit, as you constantly intercede with every form of prayer at all times. Pray the blessings of God upon all his believers.

⁴ For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds, ⁵ casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ,"

I understand that this is a church-based, Christian ministry providing pastoral and Biblically-based ministry in individual and group settings, and that the ministry is not given by professional counselors but by pastoral staff and lay-ministers (“ministers”) who are not licensed as professional counselors.

____ 2. I understand that under normal circumstances, my identity and everything I discuss with my minister will be held in strict confidence. However, I am aware there are some situations in which my minister may report information to the proper authorities without my permission or knowledge. These situations may include, but not limited to: indications of harm to self or others, involvement in a felony, suicidal intentions, and/or evidence of child or elder abuse or neglect. My minister may also disclose information in response to a subpoena issued by a court of law.

____ 3. I understand and agree that if I occupy a leadership or ministry position at Trinity Fellowship Church, my minister may also disclose information to the person in authority over me.

____ 4. I understand that all ministry files are the property of Trinity Fellowship Church and are solely within its discretionary disposition and control.
