January 15: Walking in God's Purpose

Prayer:

Strengthen us to live intentionally, seeking to honor You in all we do and using the gifts You've given us to serve others. Let us walk in boldness and faith, confident that You will equip us for every good work. May our lives be a reflection of Your love and grace, pointing others to Your Kingdom. In Jesus' name, Amen.

Prayer Points:

1. Living with Purpose

o **Jeremiah 29:11:** "For I know the plans I have for you," says the Lord. "They are plans for good and not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope."

2. Surrendering to God's Will

- o **Proverbs 3:5-6:** "Trust in the Lord with all your heart; do not depend on your own understanding. Seek his will in all you do, and he will show you which path to take."
- o **Psalm 139:13-18:** "You made all the delicate, inner parts of my body and knit me together in my mother's womb. Thank you for making me so wonderfully complex! Your workmanship is marvelous—how well I know it. You watched me as I was being formed in utter seclusion, as I was woven together in the dark of the womb. You saw me before I was born. Every day of my life was recorded in your book. Every moment was laid out before a single day had passed. How precious are your thoughts about me, O God. They cannot be numbered! I can't even count them; they outnumber the grains of sand! And when I wake up, you are still with me!"

3. Walking in Boldness and Faith

• **Ephesians 2:10:** "For we are God's masterpiece. He has created us anew in Christ *Iesus, so we can do the good things he planned for us long ago."*

January 22: Prayer for New Beginnings

Prayer:

Heavenly Father, thank You for the gift of new beginnings. In Christ, we are made new, and the old has passed away. Help us to let go of anything holding us back from fully walking in the life You have prepared. Teach us to trust in Your plans, even when we do not understand the path ahead. Give us courage to release past habits and fears, embracing our identity as Your children. Align our hearts with Your Kingdom purposes and open our eyes to the opportunities You've placed before us. As we face challenges, fill us with strength and joy. May Your Word guide our steps and remind us daily of Your faithful presence. We commit to walking in Your grace and truth, confident in the new life we have in You. In Jesus' name, Amen.

Prayer Points:

1. Gratitude for New Creation

- o **2 Corinthians 5:17:** "This means that anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person. The old life is gone; a new life has begun!"
- o **Jeremiah 29:11:** "For I know the plans I have for you," says the Lord. "They are plans for good and not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope."

2. Fresh Vision for God's Kingdom

- o **Proverbs 3:5-6:** "Trust in the Lord with all your heart; do not depend on your own understanding. Seek his will in all you do, and he will show you which path to take."
- o **Romans 12:2:** "Don't copy the behavior and customs of this world, but let God transform you into a new person by changing the way you think. Then you will learn to know God's will for you, which is good and pleasing and perfect."

3. Strength to Persevere

- o Philippians 4:13: "For I can do everything through Christ, who gives me strength."
- o **James 1:2-4:** "Dear brothers and sisters, when troubles of any kind come your way, consider it an opportunity for great joy. For you know that when your faith is tested, your endurance has a chance to grow."

January 29: Vision for God's Kingdom

Prayer:

Lord, we come to You with hearts longing for Your Kingdom to come and Your will to be done on earth as it is in heaven. Show us how to live as Kingdom ambassadors, reflecting Your love and truth in our families, workplaces, and communities. Strengthen our faith to disciple others and support those spreading the Gospel across the globe. Teach us to act wisely, aligning our daily lives with Your eternal purposes. We declare the authority You've given us through Jesus to overcome fear, temptation, and obstacles. Holy Spirit, empower us to walk boldly in Your power and discernment, trusting that You will guide our steps. May Your Kingdom expand in and through us as we surrender to Your will. In Jesus' name, Amen.

Prayer Points:

1. God's Kingdom on Earth

- o **Matthew 6:10:** "May your Kingdom come soon. May your will be done on earth, as it is in heaven."
- o **2 Corinthians 5:20:** "So we are Christ's ambassadors; God is making his appeal through us. We speak for Christ when we plead, 'Come back to God!'"

2. Faith for Kingdom Expansion

- Matthew 28:19: "Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit."
- o **Romans 10:14-15:** "How will anyone go and tell them without being sent? That is why the Scriptures say, 'How beautiful are the feet of messengers who bring good news!'"

3. Walking in Kingdom Authority

- Luke 10:19: "Look, I have given you authority over all the power of the enemy, and you can walk among snakes and scorpions and crush them. Nothing will injure you."
- o **John 10:27:** "My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me."

February 5: Living Spirit-Filled Lives

Prayer:

Heavenly Father, thank You for the gift of the Holy Spirit, who empowers us to live as Your witnesses. We ask for a fresh filling of the Spirit in our lives, that we may bear fruit and glorify You in all we do. Help us walk in step with the Spirit, surrendering to His guidance each day. Open our hearts to the gifts You have placed within us, and use them to build Your Kingdom. Empower us to boldly share the Gospel, reflecting Your love to those around us. May the Spirit's presence within us lead us to live in obedience, faith, and joy. In Jesus' name, Amen.

Prayer Points:

1. Seeking the Holy Spirit's Filling

- o **Ephesians 5:18**: "Don't be drunk with wine, because that will ruin your life. Instead, be filled with the Holy Spirit."
- Galatians 5:22-23: "But the Holy Spirit produces this kind of fruit in our lives: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. There is no law against these things!"

2. Empowerment for Ministry

- o **2 Timothy 1:7**: "For God has not given us a spirit of fear and timidity, but of power, love, and self-discipline."
- o **1 Corinthians 12:7**: "A spiritual gift is given to each of us so we can help each other."

3. Living in Step with the Spirit

- o **Galatians 5:25**: "Since we are living by the Spirit, let us follow the Spirit's leading in every part of our lives."
- o **John 16:13**: "When the Spirit of truth comes, he will guide you into all truth. He will not speak on his own but will tell you what he has heard. He will tell you about the future."

February 12: Unity in Faith

Prayer:

Lord Jesus, You prayed for unity among Your followers, and we desire to reflect that unity in the Church today. Help us to love one another with humility, patience, and kindness, recognizing that we are all part of Your body. Teach us to stand firm in the truth of Your Word and to reject anything that brings division. May we celebrate the diversity of gifts and callings You've placed within us while working together for Your Kingdom. Strengthen the bonds of fellowship in our churches, and let the unity we share be a powerful testimony to the world of Your love. In Jesus' name, Amen.

Prayer Points:

1. Unity Among Believers

- o **John 17:21**: "I pray that they will all be one, just as you and I are one—as you are in me, Father, and I am in you. And may they be in us so that the world will believe you sent me."
- **Ephesians 4:3**: "Make every effort to keep yourselves united in the Spirit, binding yourselves together with peace."

2. Grounding in the Truth

o **2 Timothy 3:16-17**: "All Scripture is inspired by God and is useful to teach us what is true and to make us realize what is wrong in our lives. It corrects us when we are wrong and teaches us to do what is right. God uses it to prepare and equip his people to do every good work."

3. Celebrating Diversity of Giftings in the Body

o 1 Corinthians 12:12-14: "The human body has many parts, but the many parts make up one whole body. So it is with the body of Christ. Some of us are Jews, some are Gentiles, some are slaves, and some are free. But we have all been baptized into one body by one Spirit, and we all share the same Spirit."

February 19: Radical Obedience

Prayer:

Father God, we desire to live lives of radical obedience to You. Help us to trust You fully, even when Your ways are challenging or unclear. Teach us to surrender our plans, ambitions, and desires to Your will, knowing that Your plans are always best. Empower us to obey promptly and joyfully, whether in small tasks or significant sacrifices. Let our obedience inspire others to follow You and bring glory to Your name. May we live as faithful disciples, bearing fruit that lasts and walking in step with Your Spirit. In Jesus' name, Amen.

Prayer Points:

1. Joyful Surrender

- o **Luke 9:23**: "Then he said to the crowd, 'If any of you wants to be my follower, you must give up your own way, take up your cross daily, and follow me.'"
- o **Joshua 1:9**: "This is my command—be strong and courageous! Do not be afraid or discouraged. For the Lord your God is with you wherever you go."

2. Obedience in Daily Life

o **Psalm 119:33-35**: "Teach me your decrees, O Lord; I will keep them to the end. Give me understanding and I will obey your instructions; I will put them into practice with all my heart. Make me walk along the path of your commands, for that is where my happiness is found."

3. Impact Through Obedience

o **Matthew 5:16**: "In the same way, let your good deeds shine out for all to see, so that everyone will praise your heavenly Father."

February 26: Humility

Prayer:

Lord Jesus, You modeled perfect humility by laying down Your life for us. Teach us to follow Your example, setting aside pride and selfish ambition to serve others in love. Help us to see ourselves as You see us—completely dependent on Your grace. Give us the courage to put others' needs ahead of our own and to reflect Your kindness and gentleness in every interaction. As we grow in humility, may our lives glorify You and draw others to Your love. In Jesus' name, Amen.

Prayer Points:

1. Acknowledging Our Dependence on God

- o **James 4:6**: "And he gives grace generously. As the Scriptures say, 'God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble.'"
- o **Proverbs 3:5-6**: "Trust in the Lord with all your heart; do not depend on your own understanding. Seek his will in all you do, and he will show you which path to take."
- Matthew 5:3: "God blesses those who are poor [in spirit] and realize their need for him, for the Kingdom of Heaven is theirs."

2. Serving Others in Love

- John 13:14-15: "And since I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you
 ought to wash each other's feet. I have given you an example to follow. Do as I
 have done to you."
- o **Philippians 2:3-4**: "Don't be selfish; don't try to impress others. Be humble, thinking of others as better than yourselves. Don't look out only for your own interests, but take an interest in others, too."

3. Reflecting Christ's Humility

o **Philippians 2:5-8**: "You must have the same attitude that Christ Jesus had. Though he was God, he did not think of equality with God as something to cling to. Instead, he gave up his divine privileges; he took the humble position of a slave and was born as a human being. When he appeared in human form, he humbled himself in obedience to God and died a criminal's death on a cross."

March 5: Compassion for Others

Prayer:

Lord, You are full of compassion and mercy, and we desire to reflect Your love to those around us. Open our hearts to the needs of others, and help us respond with kindness and generosity. Teach us to show compassion not only in action but also in thought, extending grace to those who hurt us or seem unworthy in the world's eyes. May our lives be marked by Your love, and may our compassion lead others to experience Your kindness and salvation. In Jesus' name, Amen.

Prayer Points:

1. Loving Others with Christ's Love

o **John 13:34-35**: "So now I am giving you a new commandment: Love each other. Just as I have loved you, you should love each other. Your love for one another will prove to the world that you are my disciples."

2. Compassion in Action

o **1 John 3:18**: "Dear children, let's not merely say that we love each other; let us show the truth by our actions."

3. Kindness Leading to Repentance

Romans 2:4: "Don't you see how wonderfully kind, tolerant, and patient God is with you? Does this mean nothing to you? Can't you see that his kindness is intended to turn you from your sin?"

March 12: Passover Preparation

Prayer:

Father God, thank You for the perfect sacrifice of Jesus, our Passover Lamb, who redeemed us from sin and death. As we reflect on the significance of Passover, help us to remember the price that was paid for our freedom. Teach us to walk in the victory of the cross, living lives of gratitude and obedience. Let the blood of Jesus be a covering over our lives and our families, just as the blood of the lamb protected Your people in Egypt. May we prepare our hearts to honor You during this holy season. In Jesus' name, Amen.

Prayer Points:

1. Remembering Christ's Sacrifice

o 1 Corinthians 5:7: "Christ, our Passover Lamb, has been sacrificed for us."

2. Walking in Freedom

Galatians 5:1: "So Christ has truly set us free. Now make sure that you stay free, and don't get tied up again in slavery to the law."

3. The Power of Christ's Blood

 Exodus 12:13: "But the blood on your doorposts will serve as a sign, marking the houses where you are staying. When I see the blood, I will pass over you. This plague of death will not touch you when I strike the land of Egypt."

March 19: The Cross

Prayer:

Lord Jesus, we thank You for the cross, where You bore our sins and gave us the gift of eternal life. Help us never to take Your sacrifice lightly but to live with grateful hearts, fully surrendered to You. Teach us to boast only in the cross and to proclaim the hope it brings to others. Let the power of the cross be evident in our lives, transforming us and drawing us closer to You each day. May our lives reflect the victory and love that You displayed through Your death and resurrection. In Jesus' name, Amen.

Prayer Points:

1. Gratitude for the Cross

 Galatians 6:14: "As for me, may I never boast about anything except the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ. Because of that cross, my interest in this world has been crucified, and the world's interest in me has also died."

2. Victory Through the Cross

o Colossians 2:14-15: "He canceled the record of the charges against us and took it away by nailing it to the cross. In this way, he disarmed the spiritual rulers and authorities. He shamed them publicly by his victory over them on the cross."

3. Living in the Power of the Cross

• **Luke 9:23**: "Then he said to the crowd, 'If any of you wants to be my follower, you must give up your own way, take up your cross daily, and follow me.'"

March 26: Making Disciples

Prayer:

Heavenly Father, You have called us to go and make disciples, teaching others to obey all that Jesus commanded. Give us a heart for the lost and the courage to share the Gospel boldly. Teach us to walk closely with You so that our lives reflect the transformation only You can bring. Help us to be faithful in mentoring others, encouraging them to grow in their faith. Let our lives be living examples of Your grace, pointing others to the love and truth found in Jesus. In His name, Amen.

Prayer Points:

1. Making Disciples

Matthew 28:19-20: "Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age."

2. Living as an Example

o 1 Corinthians 11:1: "And you should imitate me, just as I imitate Christ."

3. Equipping Others to Grow in Faith

 2 Timothy 2:2: "You have heard me teach things that have been confirmed by many reliable witnesses. Now teach these truths to other trustworthy people who will be able to pass them on to others."

April 2: Palm Sunday Preparation

Prayer:

Lord Jesus, as we prepare to celebrate Palm Sunday, we remember the day You entered Jerusalem as the humble King, riding on a donkey, fulfilling the prophecy. You came not as a conqueror but as the Prince of Peace, showing us the way of humility and love. We lay down our hearts before You, just as the crowds laid down palm branches. Teach us to surrender to Your lordship in every area of our lives. May we worship You with the same joy and enthusiasm as the people who cried, "Hosanna!" but with a deeper understanding of Your mission to bring salvation. Let this Palm Sunday remind us to carry Your light into a world in need of hope. We lift up our voices to declare You as King of Kings and Lord of Lords, thanking You for the peace and victory You bring. In Your holy name, Amen.

Prayer Points:

1. Honoring Jesus as King

 Zechariah 9:9: "Rejoice, O people of Zion! Shout in triumph, O people of Jerusalem! Look, your king is coming to you. He is righteous and victorious, yet he is humble, riding on a donkey—riding on a donkey's colt."

2. Surrendering to His Lordship

• Luke 19:38: "Blessings on the King who comes in the name of the Lord! Peace in heaven, and glory in highest heaven!"

3. Carrying the Good News

 Matthew 21:9: "Jesus was in the center of the procession, and the people all around him were shouting, 'Praise God for the Son of David! Blessings on the one who comes in the name of the Lord! Praise God in highest heaven!"

April 9: Easter Preparation

Prayer:

Father God, as Easter approaches, our hearts are filled with gratitude for the gift of Your Son, Jesus Christ. His death and resurrection changed everything, bringing us salvation, hope, and eternal life. Thank You for loving us so deeply that You were willing to sacrifice Your only Son to redeem us from sin and death. Lord, prepare our hearts to fully celebrate the miracle of the resurrection. Help us to let go of distractions and focus on the incredible power of the empty tomb. Fill us with the joy of knowing that Jesus has conquered death, and because of Him, we have eternal life. Teach us to live each day with that resurrection power, sharing the hope of Easter with those around us. Let our worship be filled with awe and thanksgiving as we reflect on the price You paid and the victory You won. In Jesus' name, Amen.

Prayer Points:

1. Celebrating the Resurrection

- o 1 Corinthians 15:3-9: "I passed on to you what was most important and what had also been passed on to me. Christ died for our sins, just as the Scriptures said. He was buried, and he was raised from the dead on the third day, just as the Scriptures said. He was seen by Peter and then by the Twelve. After that, he was seen by more than 500 of his followers at one time, most of whom are still alive, though some have died. Then he was seen by James and later by all the apostles. Last of all, as though I had been born at the wrong time, I also saw him. For I am the least of all the apostles. In fact, I'm not even worthy to be called an apostle after the way I persecuted God's church."
- o **1 Corinthians 15:20-23**: "But in fact, Christ has been raised from the dead. He is the first of a great harvest of all who have died. So you see, just as death came into the world through a man, now the resurrection from the dead has begun through another man. Just as everyone dies because we all belong to Adam, everyone who belongs to Christ will be given new life. But there is an order to this resurrection: Christ was raised as the first of the harvest; then all who belong to Christ will be raised when he comes back."

2. Reflecting on God's Love

o **Romans 5:8**: "But God showed his great love for us by sending Christ to die for us while we were still sinners."

3. Sharing the Joy of Easter

o **1 Peter 1:3**: "All praise to God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. It is by his great mercy that we have been born again, because God raised Jesus Christ from the dead. Now we live with great expectation."

April 16: Post-Easter Reflection

Prayer:

Heavenly Father, we thank You for the power of the resurrection. Jesus' victory over sin and death changes everything for us. As we reflect on Easter, help us to remember that this celebration isn't just one day, but a daily reality. The same Spirit that raised Christ from the dead lives in us, empowering us to walk in victory. Teach us to live with that confidence, trusting You in every situation we face. Let our hearts overflow with gratitude for the incredible gift of salvation. As we encounter challenges, remind us that we are more than conquerors through Jesus. Help us to proclaim the message of hope and life to those around us, sharing the good news of the risen Savior. May our lives be living testimonies of the resurrection's power and Your unending love. In Jesus' name, Amen.

Prayer Points:

1. Living in Resurrection Power

o **Romans 8:11**: "The Spirit of God, who raised Jesus from the dead, lives in you. And just as God raised Christ Jesus from the dead, he will give life to your mortal bodies by this same Spirit living within you."

2. Overcoming Challenges Through Faith

o **Philippians 4:13**: "For I can do everything through Christ, who gives me strength."

3. Proclaiming the Gospel

 Mark 16:15: "And then he told them, 'Go into all the world and preach the Good News to everyone.'"

April 23: Proclaiming Good News

Prayer:

Lord Jesus, You have called us to be Your witnesses, proclaiming the Good News to the world. We are humbled and honored by this mission. Fill us with boldness and courage as we share the Gospel with others. Help us to speak with clarity and love, always pointing to You as the source of hope and salvation. Equip us with the wisdom of the Holy Spirit to reach others in a way that draws them to You. May our words and actions glorify You, and may many come to know the joy and freedom found in Your name. In Jesus' name, Amen.

Prayer Points:

1. Boldness in Sharing the Gospel

o **Romans 1:16**: "For I am not ashamed of this Good News about Christ. It is the power of God at work, saving everyone who believes—the Jew first and also the Gentile."

2. Compassion for the Lost

 Matthew 9:37-38: "He said to his disciples, 'The harvest is great, but the workers are few. So pray to the Lord who is in charge of the harvest; ask him to send more workers into his fields.'"

3. Trusting the Power of the Gospel

o **Isaiah 55:11**: "It is the same with my word. I send it out, and it always produces fruit. It will accomplish all I want it to, and it will prosper everywhere I send it."

April 30: Preparation for the National Day of Prayer

Prayer:

Heavenly Father, today we join with believers tomorrow across the nation to lift our voices in prayer for our country. We thank You for the freedoms we enjoy and for the blessings You have poured out upon this land. Forgive us for the ways we have strayed from Your ways, and guide us back to a path of righteousness. 2. Healing and Unity in the Nation

o **2 Chronicles 7:14**: "Then if my people who are called by my name will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, I will hear from heaven and will forgive their sins and restore their land."

3. Revival and Righteousness

o **Proverbs 14:34**: "Godliness makes a nation great, but sin is a disgrace to any people."

4. Prayer Theme for National Day of Prayer: Pouring Out the Hope of God and Be Filled

o **Romans 15:13:** "I pray that God, the source of hope, will fill you completely with joy and peace because you trust in him. Then you will overflow with confident hope through the power of the Holy Spirit."
